Part 1 Preliminary

1 Short title

This subordinate local law may be cited as *Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2014*.

2 Subordinate local law amended

This subordinate local law amends *Subordinate Local Law No. 4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2012*.

Part 2 Amendments to subordinate local law

3 Amendment of s4 (Definitions)

(1) Section 4, from ‘Particular’ to ‘local law.’—

renumber as subsection (1).

(2) After section 4(1)—

insert—

‘(2) The dictionary in schedule 6 defines particular words used in this subordinate local law.’.

4 Amendment of sch2 (Restricted activities for local government controlled areas or roads)

(1) Schedule 2, from ‘All roads within the local government area’ to ‘from the road.’—

renumber as item 2.

(2) Schedule 2, item 2, from ‘The washing’ to ‘moved from the road.’—

renumber as item 2(a).

(3) Schedule 2, after item 2(a)—

insert—

‘

5 Insertion of new sch6 Dictionary

After schedule 5—

insert—

‘Schedule 6 Dictionary

Section 4

grid means a structure designed to —

- (a) permit the movement of pedestrian or vehicular traffic along a road; but
- (b) prevent the passage of livestock.

responsible person, for a gate or grid installed across a road, means—

- (a) the person who installed the gate or grid, or the gate and the grid; and
- (b) the person for whose use or benefit the gate or grid, or the gate and the grid, were installed; and
- (c) the person who has the benefit of the gate or grid, or the gate and the grid, installed across the road.’
