July – Dec 2018:	Focus group engagement about Tenure Framework
Dec 2018:	Tenure Framework adopted by council
Jan – Sept 2019:	Implementation of Tenure Framework
Sept 2019 & ongoing:	Transitional phase towards full tenure

AND CONTROLLED LAND



WATER AND WASTE POLICY

Consistent Level of Service
Clear roles and **responsibilities**
for council and clubs

WHAT WE CHANGED BASED ON YOUR (SPORTS CLUBS) FEEDBACK

- We'll do the mowing
- You pay for electricity.
- We share specialised maintenance with you.
- We look after major field maintenance.
- You look after general infrastructure maintenance.
- We look after major and scheduled infrastructure maintenance.
- We share the waste management fee with you and you pay collection charges.
- The water policy will be defined in 12 months. In the meantime, we complete water infrastructure upgrades.

PHASE 2 – DELIBERATION

Final documentation
and 45-day
consideration period

PHASE 3 – SIGNING OF AGREEMENT

Council and sports
clubs sign the tenure
agreement.

PHASE 4 – CHANGING OF RESPONSIBILITIES

Clubs and council take on
their new responsibilities
as per the tenure agree-
ment.
