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Central Highlands Regional Council Conditions

Schedule A: Conditions

- 1. All animals must be:
 - a) registered with Central Highlands Regional Council;
 - b) fitted with a PPID (microchip);
 - c) are to be de-sexed;
 - d) Vaccinated:
 - 1. Dog C4 vaccine
 - a. Vaccinates for: Canine Parvovirus, Distemper, Canine Hepatitis, Canine Parainfluenza
 - 2. Cat F3 vaccine
 - a. Vaccinates for: Feline Enteritis ,Feline Rhinotracheitis, Feline Calicivirus

Veterinary Certificates must be provided for proof of PPID, de-sexing, and vaccination

- 2. Only animals described in the permit are to be housed on the premises;
- 3. Adequate shelter must be provided and maintained for animals;
- 4. Dividing fences must be provided and be maintained at all times:
 - a) to prevent animals escaping from the premises;
 - b) ensuring the animal does not cause danger, nuisance inconvenience or annoyance to others;
 - c) taking measures to prevent the animal from causing injury to persons or other animals;
 - d) taking measures to protect the local environment from harm;
- 5. The area where the animals are normally kept must be clean and odour free. Faeces must be picked up and disposed of daily so as not to:
 - a) cause environmental harm
 - b) become a breeding place for flies or vermin
 - c) endanger the health or safety of any person
 - d) cause an odour nuisance
- 6. No justified complaints are to be received
- 7. Minimum standards as contained in the Central Highlands Regional Council Local Law No. 2 (Animal Management) 2012 are to be complied with
- 8. All food must be stored in vermin proof containers
- 9. A sound proof enclosure must be provided for any animal which causes or is likely to cause a noise nuisance
- 10. Breed, size, temperament and age will be considered by council
 - (i) Circumstances in which keeping of animal or animals requires approval
 - a. Dog
- i. One (1) dog over 12 weeks of age in a Multiple Dwelling (Units, duplex, townhouse, etc.) in a designated urban area
- ii. More than one (1) dog over 12 weeks of age on an allotment with an area less than or equal to 500m² in a designated urban area
- iii. More than two (2) dogs over 12 weeks of age on an allotment with an area greater than 500m² in a designated urban area
- b. Cat
- i. One (1) cat over 12 weeks of age in a Multiple Dwelling (Units, duplex, townhouse, etc.) in a designated urban area
- ii. More than one (1) cat over 12 weeks of age on an allotment with an area less than or equal to 500m² in a designated urban area
- iii. More than two (2) cats over 12 weeks of age on an allotment with an area greater than 500m² in a designated urban area

Above mentioned conditions must be complied with before permit and certificate will be granted

Schedule 4 Minimum standards for keeping animals generally

Section 8(1)

Each of the owner and responsible person for an animal must comply with the following minimum standards—

- (a) ensure that the fencing is of a standard and maintained to keep the animal on the persons property and prevent it from escaping and wandering; and
- (b) ensure that waste waters from enclosures are drained in a nuisance free manner and that run-off is kept off adjoining land or as otherwise directed by an authorised person; and
- (c) ensure that excreta, food scraps, and other material that is, or is likely to become, offensive is collected at least once in each day and, if not immediately disposed of, is kept in a fly proof container of a kind approved by an authorised person; and
- (d) ensure that any enclosure in which the animal is kept is kept in a clean and sanitary condition and free from dust and odour; and
- (e) ensure that any enclosure in which the animal is kept is properly maintained in an aesthetically acceptable condition; and
- (f) take all reasonable steps to prevent the animals from making a noise or disturbance that causes a nuisance or disturbance to the occupiers of other land or premises; and
- (g) ensure that the area available to the animal kept on the premises is appropriately sized so that the animal can be effectively and comfortably kept; and
- (h) any animal food is stored in an impervious fly proof and vermin proof receptacle or in an impervious fly proof and vermin proof storeroom facility and the receptacle or storeroom facility, as the case may be, is maintained to the satisfaction of an authorised person; and
- (i) ensure that all animals kept on the premises are provided with and have access to adequate shelter, drinking water and appropriate food; and
- (j) ensure that any enclosure used for the purpose of keeping an animal is thoroughly cleaned each week and effectively treated with an insecticide at least twice a year; and
- (k) comply with reasonable directions given by an authorised person to ensure that the keeping of the animal does not result in nuisance to occupiers of other land or premises; and
- (I) upon discovering the existence of a dead animal -
 - (i) immediately dispose of the remains of the dead animal so as not to cause a nuisance;
 - (ii) ensure that the remains are not be disposed of on or in a public place.

- 1. Ensure that the application form is entirely completed.
- 2. Draw a plan of the allotment showing the location of all buildings, structure and fences
- 3. Take Photographs of the animals enclosure and the animals, including
 - a. Fencing;
 - b. Shelter;
 - c. Food Storage; and
 - d. The animals.
- 4. Obtain the consent of each adjoining neighbour on the attached form.

 An adjoining neighbour are those who's properties share a common boundary and share a corner post
- 5. Submit your application with all the correct attachments to Council and pay the set application fee. This guide does not have to be returned with the application
- 6. If approval is granted, your permit it is valid for one (1) year.

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
