

STEP 1

Navigate to council's website at www.centralhighlands.qld.gov.au

STEP 2

On the home page, hover over the 'Building, Planning and Projects' heading in the black bar.

Navigate your mouse to the 'Planning and development information' menu item and click on it.

STEP 3

You will be redirected to the 'Planning and development information' page. Scroll down to the heading 'Track active and determined applications' and click on the link to view lodged applications.



A disclaimer will pop up on the screen. Please read this carefully and then hit the 'I agree' button located at the bottom of the page. If you don't agree, hit 'I disagree' and you will be taken back to the previous page.



STEP 4

You will now come to the 'Development applications register' page. From here there are two options for viewing lodged applications.

If you are wanting to access documentation relating to an application lodged between 1 July 2017 and 1 November 2019 follow the links.

If you are wanting to view an application made after 1 November 2019 hit the OneCouncil application tracking link.




STEP 5

In the portal click on 'Application tracking'.



STEP 6

In the search bar, type your DA number or address if the DA number is unknown. Select the appropriate application from the search results and click 'View' in the top right corner.



STEP 7

You are now able to see your DA application details, including your summary and application map, application stream and any attachments.

You can navigate through these by clicking on the corresponding tile on the left-hand side menu.

You are also able to view the summary and the application map by clicking the 2 tiles at the bottom on the right.
